Achieve, Challenge, Extend (ACE): The ACE program is designed to encourage students to pursue success in English, Maths, Science and Humanities and Social Science. The program offers opportunities for students to develop into life-long learners with a focus on achieving the skills and results required for university entrance on the completion of Year 12.

Shooting/Kicking Goals: Shooting/Kicking Goals combines sporting and high school activities to help our students achieve better educational and employment results. The program is based on a reward and incentive system, where our students are required to maintain high levels of attendance and behaviour in order to stay in the program.

The program places a strong focus on comprehensive three-four hour a week AFL/Netball/Basketball curriculum linked to the Health and Phys Ed learning outcomes. This allows students to be extended in the physical, technical, tactical and mental components of the sport. Our students are encouraged to apply their new skills within the community, benefiting the local sporting organisations with qualified coaches, umpires, trainers and administrators.

Follow the Dream: Assists Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students from Year 7 to 12 to excel at school, complete Year 12 and successfully enter University, training or meaningful employment. Follow the Dream encourages students to aim high and aspire to achieve in all aspects of life.
