#### **Information for Year 9 Parents**

Students who get to Band 8 in Reading, Writing and Numeracy in Year 9 NAPLAN are considered to have reached the basic literacy and numeracy standards – they don't have to sit the OLNA test in Year 10. OLNA consists



of three separate tests – like NAPLAN - Reading, Writing and Numeracy. Students only sit the tests they did not achieve in NAPLAN Year 9. They have two opportunities in Year 10, 11 and 12 – thus six chances altogether. When they achieve a 3, they are considered to have passed and therefore do not have to sit any further tests for that subject.

Students will not receive a Western Australia Certificate of Education at the completion of Year 12 unless they have achieved the three passes.

On Friday 8 November BHP geologists, Steve Loack and Nat Linder-Patton, visited Newman SHS for a presentation to Year 7 and 8 students about their work with NASA in the Pilbara.

The opportunity was arranged to coincide with the current science topics of rocks and minerals and planetary science.

In each year group session Pilbara geology, mining and its link to NASA's interests in the region and the 2020 Mars mission were highlighted. Starting with a 10 minute video of Pilbara geology and time for questions we then moved to a presentation on why NASA was interested in the region.

Each session finished with a short talk on the bigger NASA picture and a short video on the Artemis moon to Mars project.
