The program places a strong focus on a comprehensive four hour a week curriculum linked to the Health and Physical Education Learning Outcomes. This allows students to be extended in the physical, technical, tactical and mental components of the sport.

Our students are encouraged to apply their new skills within their community, benefiting local sporting organisations with qualified coaches, umpires, trainers and administrators
