2022 SCHOOL CHARGES AND CONTRIBUTIONS: Years 7 - 10

Dear Parent/Guardians

The school office will be open from Tuesday 25th January, 2022 from 9.00am to 3.00pm.

The 2022 school year commences for students on Monday 31st January, 2022.

The Newman Senior High School Board has endorsed the enclosed schedule of charges for lower school in 2022.

1. Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been set at \$235.00 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000.

While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes a contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments. It is vital for the school to receive your family's contribution in order to provide the best possible resources and opportunities for your child.

2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

The amounts shown represent the maximum that can be charged for scheduled activities in 2022, and are only payable if your child participates in that activity.

3. Other Voluntary Approved Requests

- The Newman Senior High School P & C Association voluntary approved request will be \$40.00 **per family**.
- The Library and Virtual Environment Fund will be \$30.00. These funds go toward valuable resources for our students in the library and technology environment.

4. Other Optional Costs

The Year Book, as always, is optional to purchase but a fantastic memoir for the school year and real value at \$45.00.

Refund of Contribution and Charges:

When a student transfers to another school, arrangements will be made to forward a pro-rata portion of their contributions and charges to their new school, providing this school is a Western Australian Public School.
